

### From the Pastor

My love of radio began as a child growing up in Houston, Texas. I can't remember what I had for breakfast this morning, but I recall my favorite DJ's introduction from 1967— "Ya Ta Haw, Ya Ta Hay, What do you know, What do you say...?!" To an 8-year-old this was Shakespeare.

The soundtrack to my childhood was hosted by Alvin Van Black (talk), Jerry Trupiano (sports), Hudson and Harrigan (morning DJ's), and Gene Elston (Astros play by play). I still remember the intro to late 60's Astro games:

It's a beautiful day for a ball game, for a ball game, to-day! The crowd is out to get a ticket or two, from Walla Walla Washington to Kalamazoo...!

Dylan could not pen a better lyric.

Bedtime was around 9 p.m. and West Coast games called for a bit of stealth after my parents offered goodnight wishes. *Step 1*: Grab transistor radio hidden under the bed. *Step 2*: Place under pillow and skillfully turn up the volume so I can listen to Gene Elston broadcast a game from far off places on the coast, San Francisco, and Los Angeles (they seemed so far away and distant, I could have been listening to a game on Mars).

The intimacy of radio has never been lost.

Notice when a long time play by play "Voice" retires - it's like they were "part of the family."

The increased popularity of podcasts seems to scratch this itch for companionship and the passage of time.

Therefore, I'm going to return to this format for a few weeks and see how it goes.

Tommy's Podcast is the creative title of this endeavor—with the goal of dropping a broadcast once per week.

I invite you to give a listen. And if it receives a decent amount of listeners and feedback, I'll continue down this road for a bit.

The format is simply something I would like to share personally or through dialogue with quests.

One more rabbit to chase...

Radio mirrors summer's slower place—listening to music or games as background noise. As you travel into the summer, slow your pace down — create "soundtracks" and memories.

Why? Well, it all goes by so fast doesn't it?

I can close my eyes and hear echoes of crowd noise from a distant game, the squeaking of a background swing rocking gently back and forth with grandfather next to meand a blessed cool summer breeze bringing relief, while eating Blue Bell Peach ice cream.... voices, places, and times long gone.

So...pull up a chair, lean in, and give a listen.
